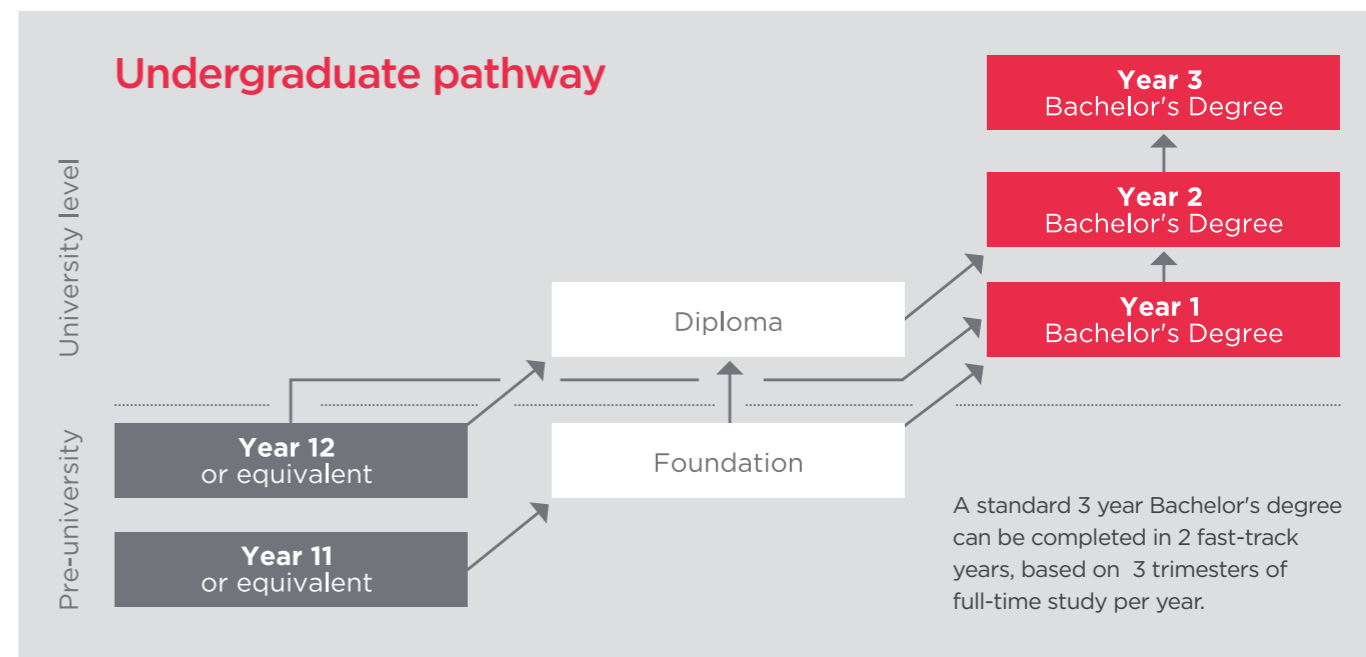
Recognition and Accreditation

Murdoch University Dubai, licenced by Knowledge and Human Development Authority (KHDA), is also regulated from Australia by the national quality assurance and regulatory agency for higher education, Tertiary Education Quality and Standards Agency (TEQSA). This double government-level oversight assures you of the highest quality international education. We offer the exact same Australian course content here in Dubai because we believe in our core purpose of providing an exceptional, international educational experience to students in the region.

Our campus in the UAE ensures that students who are unable to travel internationally for their education still have the opportunity to earn a high-quality, Australian-accredited degree, internationally recognised degree.

We have been rated 5-star for our Employability and Student Well-being efforts by KHDA in their Higher Education Classification report (2019/20). Our Dubai campus also secured a 91.1% student satisfaction rate with the industry benchmark being 60-80%, as well as 50/50 points for Career Support that's provided to our students.

For postgraduate programs, a Graduate Certificate can be completed in 1 trimester (full-time study) and the full Master's degree program can be completed in 1 year (3 trimesters of full-time study). Students may also choose to study part time and complete the program over a longer duration, based on their study load.

Should you not meet the entry requirements for direct entry into a Master's degree program, you may be eligible to start with a Graduate Certificate program, which is equivalent to one trimester of the master's degree.

Choosing what to study

We offer English language, foundation, diploma (undergraduate first year), undergraduate and postgraduate programs in a wide range of subject areas, so you can choose a course best suited to your interests and goals.

Our flexible structure means that you have a number of entry points available depending on your academic and English language qualifications.

Our undergraduate courses also provide you with an option to study two majors at one time, to broaden your qualifications and choice of careers.

Throughout the next section of this guide, explore the key topics that will be covered in each major, find out about course requirements and discover careers that you could pursue.



Courses

Program duration

The Foundation Studies program is undertaken across 3 trimesters with the option of fast-track in 2 trimesters.

The fast-track duration at Murdoch University Dubai for an undergraduate program is 2 years, based on 3 trimesters of full-time study per year, or you can choose to complete your course in the standard 3 years.

Should your academic or English language qualifications not allow direct entry into Year 1 of an undergraduate degree program, you may be eligible for entry to a Diploma program, which is equivalent to Year 1 of the standard undergraduate degree program.

foundation program

The Murdoch University Foundation Program prepares you for entry into first year of your chosen degree.

Our internationally-recognised pre-university Foundation Program prepares you for entry into the first year of your chosen degree. It equips you with the academic skills and subject knowledge required for successful admission into an undergraduate degree of your choice.

The Foundation Program bridges the gap between the qualifications students gain at high school and those needed to enter an undergraduate degree. Foundation students will study core units that prepare them for further undergraduate programs relevant to their discipline, while also having an opportunity to take elective units that interest them from a range of disciplines. Our Foundation program is TEQSA-accredited and is internationally recognised as an Australian pathway certificate for entry into Diploma and Undergraduate programs.

Progression

Students who achieve a GPA of $\geq 80\%$ can progress directly to the related undergraduate degree at Murdoch University (with no advanced standing for Foundation Program studies) at the discretion of the Murdoch Dubai Dean; and students who achieve a GPA $< 80\%$ can progress directly into the related Murdoch University diploma. On successful completion of the Murdoch University diploma, students can then progress to Year 2 of the related Murdoch University undergraduate degree with advanced standing of 24 credit points equivalent to year one of full-time undergraduate program.

A Diploma of Communication will give you a broad understanding of media and potentially lead to a wide range of roles involving professional communication skills. You will explore the cultural, social and political contexts of public communication processes and industries, institutional settings of international communication, and the way culture is expressed through media.

Once you complete the Diploma of Communication, opportunities include progression to the second year of the degree program in Communication, or an entry level position in advertising, PR, media or communication organisations.

Business



Bachelor of Business in Accounting (September 2021)

Accounting is an integral part of the management process in any business, public enterprise or not for profit entities. It acts as an evaluation and control aid when looking at the effectiveness and efficiency of the operations of an enterprise as well as employee performance. It provides information to assist users in making decisions for a variety of purposes, including the acquisition or sale of shares, lending of money, and provision of goods on credit.

You'll also learn to interpret accounting and auditing standards as you gain new skills in financial statement analysis, forecasting and budgeting, negotiation, ethical decision-making and problem-solving.

Students can benefit from ACCA exemptions for up to four subjects with the completion of certain Accounting units, saving you time and money if you choose to pursue your ACCA accountancy qualifications.

Students can satisfy the entry requirements for admission to membership of the professional accounting bodies when this major is taken in combination with the Professional Accounting Minor. These include Associate membership of CPA Australia, direct entry into the Chartered Accountants of Australia and New Zealand Programme, and Associate membership of the Institute of Public Accountants (IPA).

Bachelor of Business in Banking (September 2021)

Banking is an industry famous for offering a wide range of opportunities, great working conditions and a commitment to ongoing training and learning. Through this course, students are exposed to the issue of information asymmetry that exists between the borrower and the lender and the need to design contracts that reveal and monitor the quality of the borrower. The units also consider the nature and legal implications of the banker-customer relationship. 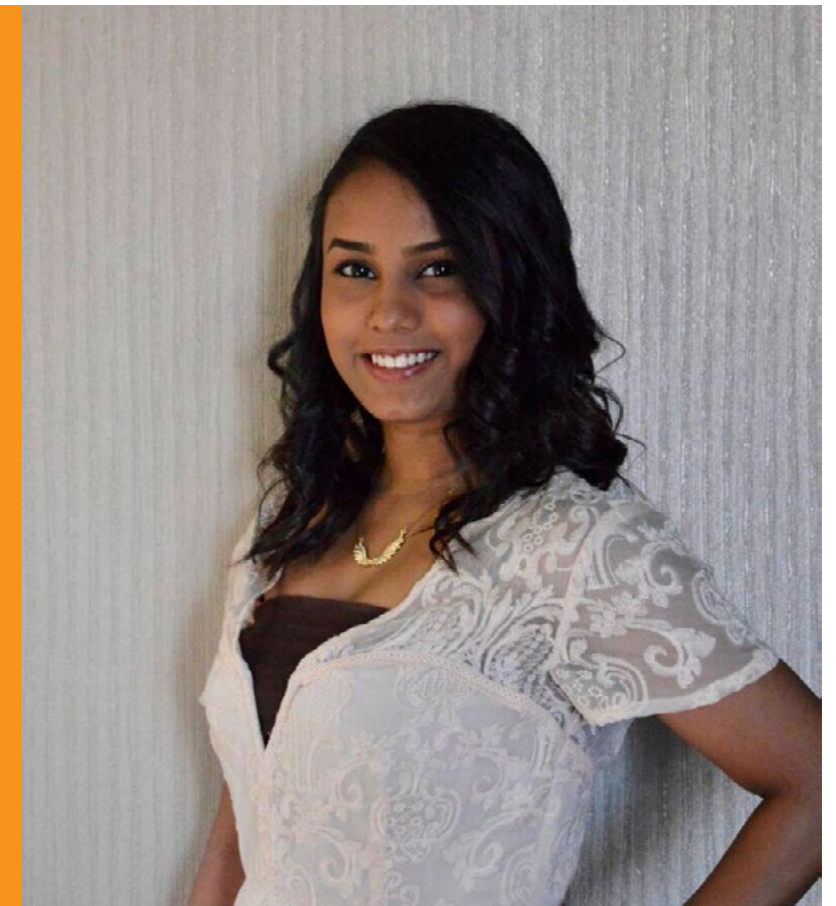

Dubai is widely known to be one of the most vibrant cities in the Middle East and is a destination that mixes modern culture with history, adventure, world-class shopping and entertainment, as well as numerous man-made architectural feats and attractions to keep you busy. Surrounded by sand dunes, the city has stunning beaches and warm waters, with year-round sunshine. Dubai was recently named one of the most attractive destinations in the world for students seeking to pursue studies abroad.

Climate

Dubai is known for warm and sunny weather throughout the year, due to its latitude. There are two distinct seasons - summer and winter. Dubai summers are milder than most nearby Gulf cities due to its coastal location.

The winter season is typically considered to begin in October and last until April - but temperatures remain pleasant and consistently suitable for a range of fun outdoor activities.

Culture and customs

Dubai is a cosmopolitan city, a melting pot of diverse cultures and religious faiths. Whilst Islam is the official religion of the United Arab Emirates, Christian, Hindu, Sikh, Buddhist and other religious communities are peacefully co-exist throughout the UAE.

Dubai is a very safe city and has consistently featured as one of the ten safest cities in the world.

Language

Although Arabic is the official language of the UAE, English is the second most common language used due to the large expatriate community.

Studying in Dubai, is a unique opportunity to experience different cultures in a safe, welcoming environment whilst developing personal, professional and language skills in an international context.

Dress code

Dubai is a cosmopolitan city that is a melting pot of diverse cultures and religious faiths. All attires and cultural preferences are generally acceptable. Swimwear is permissible on beaches, and for waterbased entertainment but is not considered appropriate in areas such as business districts and shopping malls. It is pertinent to note that in the more historical quarters of the city and places of religious worship, dressing conservatively is appreciated.

Restaurants and night life

The restaurants in Dubai are as diverse as the city's cultural fabric. You can dine out on almost any budget and experience a variety of food of food from across the globe. Outdoor dining is common in the cooler months, providing a pleasant atmosphere to catch up with friends.

Transportation

Dubai has an efficient and cost effective public transport system that connects the city. Students can take advantage of subsidized fares with a student Nol card.

Buses run regularly during the day from 4.25am to 1.00am and night buses operate every 30 minutes from 11.30pm until 6.00am.

The Dubai Metro currently operates two lines, with trains running every few minutes between 5.00am and 1.00am. Taxis are also amongst the most frequently used form of transport in Dubai.

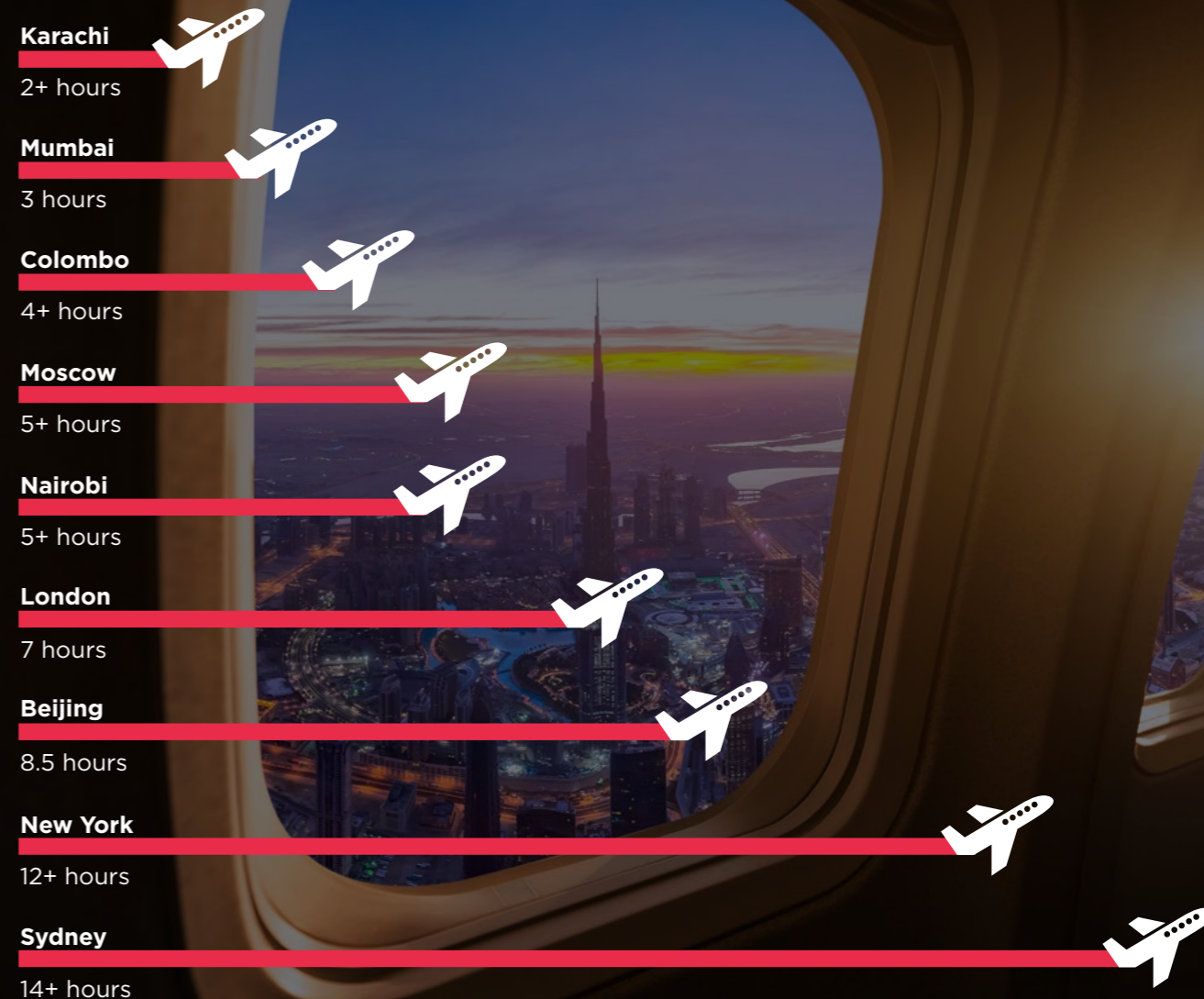
Shopping

Cost of living

The cost of living in Dubai will vary depending on where you live and other factors. Basic products and services are reasonably priced and there are regular sales and promotions on consumer goods. There is no tax on salaries in the UAE and Value Added Tax on commodities is very minimal. Students are also eligible for special discounts to use public transport and access prominent sights like museums and other touristic attractions.

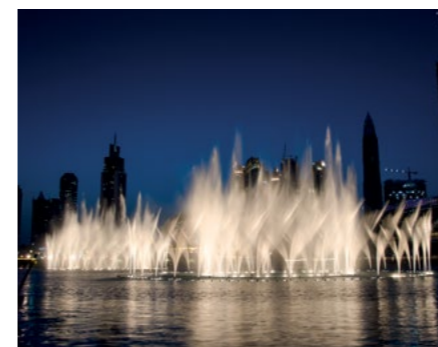

Understanding your student visa

It is mandatory for all students studying in the UAE to hold a valid residence visa. Murdoch University Dubai provides UAE Student Residence Visas through the Dubai Development Authority along with full support during the process.

Additional information

UAE Student visas are valid for a period of 12 months and will be renewed at the end of each 12-month period.

Health insurance

All international students in UAE must have health insurance for the duration of their visa. Please note that students will receive health insurance cover after the student has attended their medicals and the visa is stamped in the passport. In the interim, students will have to arrange their own health insurance.

Our health insurance provides round-the-clock cover for expenses incurred by students in a wide network of hospitals and clinics in the UAE, whether as an outpatient, inpatient or emergency admission.



Students are advised to have adequate medical insurance in UAE until their student visa has been stamped on their passport.

1. Entry Permit

Your Entry Permit will be processed once you have met the conditions of your offer and the fees have been paid. The process normally takes between 15-20 working days.

2. Student Residence Visa

You will need to submit your passport at the University to have the Student Residence Visa placed in your passport. As part of the visa process, you will be required to undergo medical and biometric testing. Approximately 15 working days following the test, your passport will be returned with your Student Residence Visa.

3. Emirates ID card

Once your visa is granted, you will be issued with your Emirates ID card. The Emirates ID card is your legal documentation in UAE and must always be carried with you. Further information on the Emirates ID card can be found at ica.gov.ae
